Family Health Partnership Clinic is a member of the Illinois Association of Free and Charitable Clinics (IAFCC). We are a 501c3 not for profit serving the uninsured residents of McHenry County.

Family Health's mission is to improve the health status of the community and reduce the negative impact of poor access to care by providing a broad spectrum of services to the underserved with compassion and respect. We recognize that as a community, we are responsible for each other. FHPC serves approximately 2,200 uninsured, low-income adults each year through its medical clinic, and outreach programs. Many of our patients are living with at least one chronic condition (high blood pressure, diabetes, and high cholesterol are most common), which requires ongoing preventative care and medications for management. We also support a dental clinic.

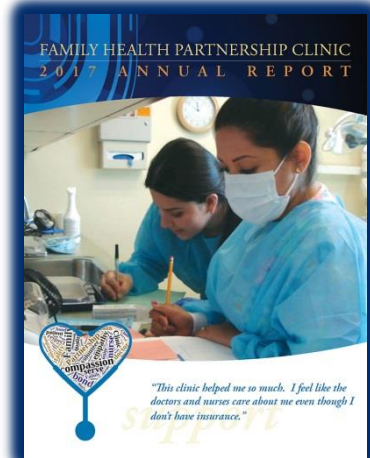
At Family Health Partnership Clinic, the VISTA will:

- Be a significant part of a pilot program for our patients
- Enjoy networking with patient resources in our community
- Screen patients for social determinants of health
- Have complete access to HealthLeads Learning Platform
- Develop workflow and follow up process with patients
- Review and implement screening tools
- Work closely with Volunteer Director to recruit volunteer team
- Train volunteers on patient screening tool, execute tool and evaluate effectiveness
- Make great use of critical thinking and computer skills
- Work full time **7/20/18-7/19/19** (can adjust for right candidate)
